ReStore Floor Project



Flooring refurbishment in the Lima ReStore began on Saturday, February 17, 2018. On that day 92 volunteers, plus about 25 staff moved all the ReStore showroom inventory into storage for a week. 325 total volunteers hours were generously offered. Semi-trailers and storage pods were filled. Immediately after, Re-Deck of Northwestern Ohio began repairing the showroom floor and laying down a new surface, which offers a safer environment for our shopping and a needed facelift for the look of the ReStore. Then on February 24, 71 more volunteers, plus numerous staff members moved all the inventory back into place. In total we had 170 volunteers give 727 hours to the project. This was a major undertaking for the Habitat and ReStore staff. We are appreciative to the many sponsors and volunteers who helped make this possible.
