Elida Build



The lot at 207 W. North Street, Elida, OH is waiting for a Habitat family to be selected, so that we can start building. This will be the first time that the Lima Area Affiliate has built a home in Elida. Our other 54 houses have been constructed in Lima, Delphos, and Spencerville. Currently our Family Services and Selection Committee is busy meeting with possible families for this new home. Once the family has been selected, then plans will be drawn up for the appropriate size house to fit the family: 2, 3, 4 or more bedrooms. The selection will hopefully be finalized by late spring. All of our committees are busy planning for this event as we will need to raise funds for the build, find sponsors, recruit volunteers, collect supplies, procure sub-contractors and more. Many of the Elida area churches are working together to consider creating an Interfaith Build Consortium.

ONU Volunteers



The Ohio Northern University Habitat for Humanity Student Chapter continues to partner with us at the Lima Area Affiliate. On Saturday, February 2, 16 students volunteered at the ReStore. This was the third time this academic year that the ONU student chapter has sent us volunteers. They have contributed over 1,000 volunteer hours since August. Projects from this visit included clearing a huge mound of snow and ice from the parking lot and sidewalk by the Habitat office, painting many of the walls of our new volunteer breakroom/offices in the ReStore, cleaning household items, and repairing donated furniture to be sold on the floor. The energy and enthusiasm was contagious as the ReStore and surrounding area was transformed. We will partner with ONU again on April 6 during their LOVE (Living Our Values Everywhere) Day.
